VI. Instructions for Completing Application

GENERAL: Sewer and Water work shall not be started until the application for the permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection please provide at least 24 hours notice. The inspector will need the job location and permit number. EXPIRATION OF A PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED.**
