## 2. FOLLOW UP ON SOLAR ORDINANCE

R. CARUSO RECOMMENDS THE TOWNSHIP HAVE A CASH ACCOUNT OF A MINIMUM OF 10% (FUNDED MONTHLY BY SOLAR LEASEE OR PROPERTY OWNER) TO DECOMMISSION LAND WHEN THE TIME COMES. FAILURE TO CONTRIBUTE MONEY WOULD RESULT IN A LIEN OF THE PROPERTY.

R. CARUSO RECOMMENDS SOLAR PANELS TO BE INSTALLED WITH CONCRETE-TOWNSHIP REQUIRES A PERMIT TO INSTALL ANY STRUCTURE WITH CONCRETE. THE TOWNDSHIP WOULD REQUIRE REMOVAL OF CONCRETE AT DECOMMISSIONING.

\* IT WOULD BE IN THE TOWNSHIPS BEST INTEREST TO HAVE A PRE-CONSTRUCTION DRONE FOOTAGE ADDED TO ALL SITE PLANS. IT MUST INCUDE HAUL ROUTE PLAN IN ADDITION TO WEIGHT AND SEASONAL ROAD RESTRICTIONS. THE TOWNSHIP COULD POSSIBLY BEGIN CHARGING FOR DECOMMISSION FEES ONCE THE TOWNSHIP RECEIVES SITE PLAN.
