1. FOLLOW UP ON SOLAR ORDINANCE

Mr. Caruso contacted a local lease representative and was advised that there are no decommissioned solar farms within 1,000 of this area. Question to this commission is how do we want to proceed? Two unsolicited letters were sent to the Township which are against solar farming in the Clayton Township community.

Next step should be to send the current ordinance draft to the Board for review and comments.

Discussion continued relative to battery storage and land values.

Mr. Caruso spoke with the Assessor and was advised that these could be taxed as industrial facilities until such time as lobbyists eliminate that ability. Question was raised as to how Shiawassi County taxed their solar farm, Mr. Caruso will ask Assessor to get this information and report back to the Planning Commissioners. Also, discussed was the impact on surrounding property values and if assessments could be levied if road damage occurred during installation of solar farm.

It was determined that battery containment requirements and decommissioning could be addressed at time of site plan review.
